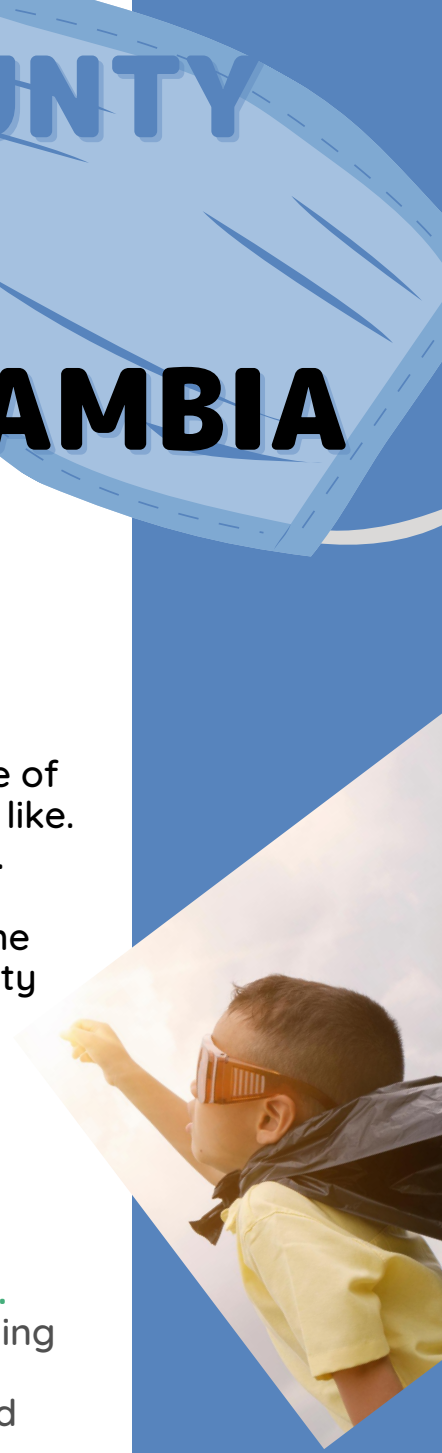
RULES:
